Here's a checklist for what you might need:

- Business License
- Seller's Permit (Sales Tax Permit)
- Home Occupation Permit
- Federal Employer Identification Number (EIN)
- Business Name Registration (DBA - Doing Business As)
- Cottage Food Permit (if applicable)
- Special Permits for Selling at Markets and Fairs
- Insurance (Some facilities may require you to have it.)
